1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
2 designated §21-11-6a, relating to listing contractor classifications on a contractor license.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 11. WEST VIRGINIA CONTRACTOR LICENSING ACT.

§21-11-6a. Classifications included on license.

1 Every license shall specify the contractor classification for which the applicant has
2 requested licensure and for which the applicant has successfully completed the required
3 examination. For specialties for which the board does not require examination, other than the
4 Business and Law examination, the license shall include each specialty classification the
5 applicant requests to be included on the license with no limitation as to the number of such
6 specialty classifications.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to allow untested specialty classifications to be listed on a person's contractor license, with no limitation as to the number of classifications.
