1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to authorizing the Board of Physical Therapy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to  
3 fees for physical therapist and physical therapist assistants.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**§64-9-1. Board of Physical Therapy.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 28, 2020, authorized under the  
2 authority of §30-20-6 of this code, modified by the Board of Physical Therapy to meet the  
3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
4 December 16, 2020, relating to the Board of Physical Therapy (fees for physical therapist and  
5 physical therapist assistants, [16 CSR 04](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Physical Therapy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to fees for physical therapist and physical therapist assistants.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
