- 1 A BILL to repeal §8-13-6 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to the repeal
- 2 of the municipal amusement tax.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 13. TAXATION AND FINANCE.

§1. Repeal of the amusement tax.

1 That §8-13-6 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, is repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal the municipal amusement tax.
