1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-6-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to authorizing the State Emergency Response Commission to promulgate a legislative  
3 rule relating to emergency planning and community right-to-know.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS AND  
PUBLIC SAFETY TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-6-1. State Emergency Response Commission.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 28, 2020, authorized under the  
2 authority of §15-5A-5 of this code, relating to the State Emergency Response Commission  
3 (emergency planning and community right to know, [55 CSR 01](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the State Emergency Response Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to emergency planning and community right to know.
