1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-7-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Insurance Commissioner to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
 3 health benefit plan network access and adequacy.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO PROMULGATE
 LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-7-1. Insurance Commissioner.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 11, 2020, authorized under the
 2 authority of §33-55-9 of this code, modified by the Insurance Commissioner to meet the objections
 3 of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on November
 4 17, 2020, relating to the Insurance Commissioner (health benefit plan network access and
 5 adequacy, [114 CSR 100](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Insurance Commissioner to promulgate a legislative rule relating to health benefit plan network access and adequacy.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
