1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating
 3 to emergency temporary permits to practice during states of emergency or states of
 4 preparedness.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Osteopathic Medicine.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on June 22, 2020, authorized under the
 2 authority of §30-14-14 of this code, modified by the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to meet the
 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
 4 November 23, 2020, relating to the Board of Osteopathic Medicine (emergency temporary permits
 5 to practice during states of emergency or states of preparedness, [24 CSR 09](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to emergency temporary permits to practice during states of emergency or states of preparedness.
