1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to licensure
 3 of wholesale drug distributors, third-party logistics providers, and manufacturers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Pharmacy.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 26, 2020, authorized under the
 2 authority of §60A-8-9 of this code, modified by the Board of Pharmacy to meet the objections of
 3 the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on December 2,
 4 2020, relating to the Board of Pharmacy (licensure of wholesale drug distributors, third party
 5 logistics providers, and manufacturers, [15 CSR 05](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to licensure of wholesale drug distributors, third party logistics providers, and manufacturers.
