1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-10-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to authorizing the Department of Commerce to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
3 tourism development districts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-10-1. Department of Commerce.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 25, 2020, authorized under the
2 authority of §5B-1-9(p) of this code, modified by the Department of Commerce to meet the
3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
4 December 10, 2020, relating to the Department of Commerce (tourism development districts, [145](#)
5 [CSR 16](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Commerce to promulgate a legislative rule relating to tourism development districts.
