1	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article,
2	designated §3-11A-1, §3-11A-2, §3-11A-3, §3-11A-4, and §3-11A-5, all relating to
3	providing procedures for West Virginia to select delegates to an Article V convention for
4	proposing amendments to the Constitution of the United States of America; defining terms;
5	directing Legislature to establish committee of correspondence for Article V convention;
6	authorizing participation by delegates in Article V convention only when each state has
7	equal vote; setting forth delegate duties and responsibilities; setting forth oath for
8	candidate for delegate or alternate; designating delegates and alternates as public officials
9	and subject to West Virginia Governmental Ethics Act; providing for immediate recall of
10	delegate casting unauthorized vote and replacement with alternate; directing Legislature
11	to certify certain information to Article V convention; making violation of delegate's oath a
12	felony; and providing criminal penalties for violation of a delegate's oath.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 11A. AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES.

§3-11A-1. Definitions.

- 1 For the purposes of this article:
- 2 <u>"Article V convention" means a convention for proposing amendments as expressly</u>
- 3 provided in Article V of the Constitution of the United States of America.
- 4 <u>"Article V application" means a joint resolution passed by the Legislature on the same</u>
- 5 <u>subject, or containing the same proposed amendment text, as thirty-three other sovereign states</u>
- 6 requiring Congress to call an Article V convention by setting the time and place.
- 7 <u>"Delegate" or "alternate" means a person selected by the Legislature or any other method</u>
- 8 provided by law to represent the State of West Virginia at an Article V convention.
- 9 <u>"Legislative instructions" mean instructions given by the Legislature to delegates and</u>
- 10 <u>alternates before and during an Article V convention.</u>
- 11 <u>"Unauthorized amendment" means a proposed amendment that is outside the subject</u>

§3-11A-2. Committee of correspondence for Article V convention.

- 1 (a) The Legislature shall designate one or more legislative committees for purposes of 2 communicating, exchanging information and otherwise engaging in discussion and dialogue with 3 the several states and congressional delegation regarding acts, resolutions and issues that may 4 be the subject of an Article V convention, and the rules, processes, potential amendments, 5 procedures for proposing amendments, interstate compacts, common credentials and 6 instructions for delegates that may govern an Article V convention. 7 (b) The Legislature may vest this function in the Joint Committee on Government and 8 Finance, in existing committees of each chamber or other legislative committee or committees it 9 may establish. §3-11A-3. Prohibition against participation in Article V convention requiring proportional representation. 1 Delegates from West Virginia are only authorized to attend an Article V convention for 2 proposing amendments where each state has one equal vote. No delegate or alternate from West 3 Virginia may attend an Article V convention for the purpose of proposing amendments that require 4 proportional representation of any state based on its respective populations. §3-11A-4. Delegate duties and responsibilities. 1 (a) Every candidate for delegate or alternate from West Virginia to the Article V convention 2 shall take the following oath: "I do solemnly swear or affirm that, to the best of my abilities, I will, 3 as a delegate or alternate to an Article V convention, uphold the constitution and laws of the 4 United States of America and the State of West Virginia. I will not vote to allow consideration of 5 or to approve any unauthorized amendment proposed for ratification to the United States of 6 America Constitution".
- 7 (b) The Legislature, or an official or committee authorized pursuant to §3-11A-2(b) of this
 8 code, shall certify in writing to the Article V convention the delegates and alternates selected, the

- 9 amendments a delegate or alternate is authorized to consider and vote to approve, the recall
- 10 procedures set forth in subsection (c) of this section and the mandatory nullification of any votes
- 11 cast by a delegate or alternate on an unauthorized amendment.
- 12 (c) Any delegate casting a vote to allow consideration or approval of an unauthorized
- 13 amendment shall be immediately recalled by an official or committee authorized pursuant to §3-
- 14 <u>11A-2(b) of this code and be replaced by an alternate.</u>
- 15 (d) Delegates may not vote to allow consideration of, or vote to approve, an unauthorized
- 16 amendment for ratification to the Constitution of the United States. Any such vote is an
- 17 <u>unauthorized vote and is void.</u>
- 18 (e) Any delegate or alternate is a public official, as that term is defined in §6B-1-3 of this
- 19 code, and is subject to the requirements of the West Virginia Governmental Ethics Act.

§3-11A-5. Violation of oath; criminal penalty.

- 1 Any delegate who violates the oath contained in this article is guilty of a felony and, upon
- 2 conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than \$100,000 nor more than \$500,000 and be
- 3 imprisoned in a state correctional facility not less than ten years.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide a procedure for West Virginia to select delegates to an Article V Convention for proposing amendments to the Constitution of the United States of America. The bill defines terms. The bill sets forth delegate duties and responsibilities. The bill provides a felony criminal penalty for violation of a delegate's oath.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
