4	WHEREAS, The Governor submitted to the Legislature the Executive Budget Document,	
5	dated February 10, 2021, which included a statement of the State Road Fund setting forth therein	
6	the cash balances and investments as of July 1, 2020, and further included the estimate of	
7	revenues for the fiscal year 2021, less regular appropriations for the fiscal year 2021; and	
8	WHEREAS, It appears from the Statement of the State Road Fund there now remains an	
9	unappropriated balance in the State Treasury which is available for appropriation during the fiscal	
10	year ending June 30, 2021; therefore	
11	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:	
12	That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, to fund 9007, fiscal	
13	year 2021, organization 0802, be supplemented and amended by increasing existing items of
