- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §39-4-6 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to permitting personal appearance by video technology before notarial officer.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 4. REVISED UNIFORM LAW ON NOTARIAL ACTS.

§39-4-6. Personal appearance required.

- 1 If a notarial act relates to a statement made in or a signature executed on a record, the
- 2 individual making the statement or executing the signature shall appear personally before the
- 3 notarial officer. An For the purposes of this section, an individual making the statement or
- 4 executing the signature does not appear <u>appears</u> personally if the appearance is by video or audio
- 5 technology. even if the video is synchronous

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to permit personal appearance by video technology.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
