1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
2 designated as §18-2-7g, relating to sexuality; forbidding displays relating to sexuality in
3 public school facilities and forbidding the teaching of sexuality in public schools.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 **§18-2-7g. Displays and, teaching related to sexuality forbidden.**

2 The state board shall prohibit persons from putting up displays relating to sexuality in
3 public school facilities and shall forbid the teaching of sexuality in public schools.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to forbid displays relating to sexuality and to forbid the teaching of sexuality in public schools.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
