relating to making the best interest of the child the sole consideration in granting

3 grandparent visitation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

#### ARTICLE 10. GRANDPARENT VISITATION.

#### §48-10-501. Necessary findings for grant of reasonable visitation to a grandparent.

- 1 The circuit court or family court shall grant reasonable visitation to a grandparent upon a
- 2 the sole finding that visitation would be in the best interests of the child-and would not substantially
- 3 interfere with the parent-child relationship.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to make the best interest of the child to be the sole consideration in granting grandparent visitation.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
