1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-5-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule
3 relating to Requirements for the Management of Coal Combustion Residuals.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
PROTECTION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-5-1. Department of Environmental Protection.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2021, authorized under the
2 authority of §22-15-10 of this code, relating to the Department of Environmental Protection
3 (Requirements for the Management of Coal Combustion Residuals, [33 CSR 01B](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Requirements for the Management of Coal Combustion Residuals.
