1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-7-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to authorizing the Insurance Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
3 Continuing Education for Individual Insurance Producers and Individual Insurance
4 Adjusters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO PROMULGATE
LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-7-1. Insurance Commission.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 8, 2021, authorized under the
2 authority of §33-12B-12 of this code, relating to the Insurance Commission (Continuing Education
3 for Individual Insurance Producers and Individual Insurance Adjusters, [114 CSR 42](#)), is
4 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Insurance Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Continuing Education for Individual Insurance Producers and Individual Insurance Adjusters.
