1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Department of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
 3 Farmers Markets.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Department of Agriculture.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2021, authorized under the
 2 authority of §19-35-4 of this code, modified by the Department of Agriculture to meet the
 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
 4 October 5, 2021, relating to the Department of Agriculture (Farmers Markets, [61 CSR 38](#)), is
 5 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Farmers Markets.
