1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Board of Counseling to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Licensed
 3 Professional Counselors Fees Rule.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Counseling.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2021, authorized under the
 2 authority of §30-31-6 of this code, modified by the Board of Counseling to meet the objections of
 3 the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on December
 4 13, 2021, relating to the Board of Counseling (Licensed Professional Counselors Fees Rule, [27](#)
 5 [CSR 02](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Counseling to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Licensed Professional Counselors Fees Rule.
