1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
 2 to authorizing the Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Licensure,  
 3 Practice Requirements, Disciplinary and Complaint Procedures, Continuing Education,  
 4 Physician Assistants.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO  
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Board of Medicine**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2021, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §30-3E-3 of this code, modified by the Board of Medicine to meet the objections of  
 3 the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on November 2,  
 4 2021, relating to the Board of Medicine (Licensure, Practice Requirements, Disciplinary and  
 5 Complaint Procedures, Continuing Education, Physician Assistants, [11 CSR 01B](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Licensure, Practice Requirements, Disciplinary and Complaint Procedures, Continuing Education, Physician Assistants.
