1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-10-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
 2 to authorizing the Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training to promulgate a legislative  
 3 rule relating to Governing the Safety of Those Employed in and Around Surface Mines in  
 4 West Virginia.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO  
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-10-1. Miners' Health, Safety and Training.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on June 11, 2021, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §22A-1-42 of this code, modified by the Office of Miners' Health, Safety And Training  
 3 to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State  
 4 Register on August 24, 2021, relating to the Office Miners' Health, Safety And Training (Rule  
 5 Governing the Safety of Those Employed in and Around Surface Mines in West Virginia, [56 CSR](#)  
 6 [03](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Miners' Health, Safety and Training to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Governing the Safety of Those Employed in and Around Surface Mines in West Virginia.
