## House Bill 4717

1	A BILL supplementing and amending the appropriations of public moneys out of the Treasury
2	from the balance of moneys remaining as an unappropriated balance in the State Fund,
3	General Revenue, to the Department of Revenue, West Virginia Office of Tax Appeals,
4	fund 0593, fiscal year 2022, organization 0709, by supplementing and amending the
5	appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022.
6	WHEREAS, The Governor submitted the Executive Budget Document to the Legislature
7	on January 12, 2022, containing a statement of the State Fund, General Revenue, setting forth
8	therein the cash balance as of July 1, 2021, and further included the revised estimate of revenue
9	for the fiscal year 2022, less net appropriation balances forwarded and regular and surplus
10	appropriations for the fiscal year 2022; and
11	WHEREAS, It appears from the Governor's Statement of the State Fund, General
12	Revenue, there now remains an unappropriated balance in the Treasury which is available for
13	appropriation during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022; therefore
14	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
15	That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, to fund 0593, fiscal
16	year 2022, organization 0709, be supplemented and amended by increasing an existing item of
17	appropriation as follows:
