1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article,
 2 designated §16-65-1, relating to establishing a program to provide a CARE FOR ALL
 3 telephone referral number and website access to provide public access to resources for
 4 medical care, including resources and providers that are LGBTQ+, Black, and POC-
 5 friendly.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 65. CARE FOR ALL RESOURCE LINE AND WEBSITE.

§16-65-1. Establishment of a CARE FOR ALL resource telephone line and website.

1 The Secretary shall establish a program to provide a CARE FOR ALL telephone referral
 2 number and website to provide public access to resources for medical care. The program shall
 3 provide an all-inclusive medical care resource phone number and website and should include
 4 names and numbers for mental health resources, doctors, and health care providers that are
 5 LGBTQ+, Black, and POC-friendly. The program shall also provide access to medical resources
 6 for persons that do not have insurance and Medicare coverage or options.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to establish a program to provide a CARE FOR ALL telephone referral number and website to provide public access to resources for medical care, including resources and providers that are LGBTQ+, Black, and POC-friendly.
