1 A BILL to repeal §17C-15-44 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to safety  
2 equipment and requirements for motorcyclists.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 15. EQUIPMENT.**

**§1. Repeal of section creating Safety equipment and requirements for motorcyclists, motorcycles, motor-driven cycles, and mopeds; motorcycle safety standards and education committee.**

1 That §17C-15-44 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended is repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal helmet requirement for motorcyclists.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
