1 A BILL to amend and reenact §17B-2-15 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the commissioner to promulgate a legislative rule to develop a driver's
 3 license permit process for parolees under supervision by the West Virginia Division of
 4 Corrections and parole services.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. ISSUANCE OF LICENSE, EXPIRATION AND RENEWAL.

§17B-2-15. Authority for Rules.

1 The commissioner may propose legislative rules for promulgation that are necessary to
 2 carry out the examination, license and endorsement provisions of this chapter and the provisions
 3 regarding motor vehicle registration in accordance with the provisions of ~~article three, chapter~~
 4 ~~twenty-nine-a §29A-3-1 et seq.~~ of this code. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, the
 5 commissioner shall propose a legislative rule for promulgation that is necessary to develop a
 6 driver's license permit process for parolees under supervision by the West Virginia Division of
 7 Corrections and parole services.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the commissioner to promulgate a legislative rule related to developing a driver's license permit process for parolees under supervision by the West Virginia Division of Corrections and parole services.
