1	A BILL expiring funds to the balance of the Department of Environmental Protection, Division of
2	Environmental Protection - Reclamation of Abandoned and Dilapidated Property Program
3	Fund, fund 3305, fiscal year 2022, organization 0313, in the amount of \$10,000,000, from
4	the Executive, Governor's Office, Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund, fund 8823,
5	fiscal year 2022, organization 0100, by supplementing and amending the appropriations
6	for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022.
7	Whereas, The Governor finds the account balance in the Executive, Governor's Office -
8	Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund, fund 8823, organization 0100 exceeds that which is
9	necessary for the purposes for which the account was established; therefore
10	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
11	That the balance of funds available for expenditure in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022,
12	to the Governor's Office - Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund, fund 8823, organization 0100,
13	be decreased by expiring the amount of \$10,000,000 to the Department of Environmental
14	Protection, Division of Environmental Protection - Reclamation of Abandoned and Dilapidated
15	Property Program Fund, fund 3305, fiscal year 2022, organization 0313.

NOTE: The purpose of supplemental appropriation bill is to expire funds from the aforesaid account for the designated spending units for expenditure during the fiscal year 2022.

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
