## **Senate Bill 300**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-5-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
 2 to authorizing the Department of Health and Human Resources and Insurance  
 3 commissioner to promulgate a legislative rule relating to all—payer claims database - data  
 4 submission requirements.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN  
 RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources and Insurance Commission.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2021, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §33-4A-8 of this code, modified by the Department of Health and Human Resources  
 3 and Insurance Commission to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review  
 4 Committee and refiled in the State Register on December 27, 2021, relating to the Department of  
 5 Health and Human Resources and Insurance Commission (All Payer Claims Database - Data  
 6 Submission Requirements , [114A CSR 01](#)), is authorized with the amendments set forth below:

7 On page 3, subsection 2.20. by striking out the word “procedural” and inserting in lieu  
 8 thereof the word “legislative”; And

9 On page 5, subsection 4.2. by striking out the word “procedural” and inserting in lieu  
 10 thereof the word “legislative”

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources and Insurance Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to All Payer Claims Database - Data Submission Requirements.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
