1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-6-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to authorizing the Fire Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to use of
3 aqueous film-forming foam for fire training program purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-6-1. Fire Commission.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2021, authorized under the
2 authority of §29-3-5g of this code, relating to the Fire Commission (Use of Aqueous Film-Forming
3 Foam (AFFF) for Fire Training Program Purposes, [87 CSR 14](#)), is authorized.
