## **Senate Bill 348**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to authorizing the Board of Chiropractic Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating  
3 to chiropractic telehealth practice.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO  
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Chiropractic Examiners.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 13, 2021, authorized under the  
2 authority of §30-16-5 of this code, modified by the Chiropractic Examiners to meet the objections  
3 of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on December  
4 15, 2021, relating to the Chiropractic Examiners (Chiropractic Telehealth Practice, [4 CSR 09](#)), is  
5 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Chiropractic Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Chiropractic Telehealth Practice.
