## **Senate Bill 363**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to authorizing the Massage Therapy Board to promulgate a legislative rule relating to  
3 general provisions.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO  
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Massage Therapy Board**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2021, authorized under the  
2 authority of §30-37-6 of this code, modified by the Massage Therapy Board to meet the objections  
3 of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on September  
4 1, 2021, relating to the Massage Therapy Board (General Provisions, [194 CSR 01](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Massage Therapy Board to promulgate a legislative rule relating to General Provisions.
