1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the
3 Controlled Substances Monitoring Program.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Pharmacy.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 21, 2021, authorized under the
2 authority of §60A-9-6 of this code, modified by the Board of Pharmacy to meet the objections of
3 the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on September
4 28, 2021, relating to the Board of Pharmacy (Controlled Substances Monitoring Program, [15](#)
5 [CSR 08](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the Controlled Substances Monitoring Program.
