## **Senate Bill 378**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to  
3 regulations governing pharmacists.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO  
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Board of Pharmacy.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 21, 2021, authorized under the  
2 authority of §30-5-7 of this code, modified by the Board of Pharmacy to meet the objections of the  
3 Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on September 29,  
4 2021, relating to the Board of Pharmacy (Regulations Governing Pharmacists, [15 CSR 16](#)), is  
5 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Regulations Governing Pharmacists.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
