- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Public Service Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
- 3 the occupancy of customer-provided conduit.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

# ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Public Service Commission.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 6, 2021, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §24-2E-3 of this code, modified by the Public Service Commission to meet the
- 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
- 4 August 24, 2021, relating to the Public Service Commission (Rules Governing the Occupancy of
- 5 Customer-Provided Conduit, 150 CSR 37), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Public Service Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Rules Governing the Occupancy of Customer-Provided Conduit.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
