1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board to promulgate
 3 a legislative rule relating to requirements for registration and renewal of appraisal
 4 management companies.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2021, authorized under the
 2 authority of §30-38A-2 of this code, modified by the Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and
 3 Certification Board to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
 4 refiled in the State Register on December 21, 2021, relating to the Real Estate Appraiser
 5 Licensing and Certification Board (Requirements for Registration and Renewal of Appraisal
 6 Management Companies, [190 CSR 05](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Requirements for Registration and Renewal of Appraisal Management Companies.
