1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to authorizing the Board of Registered Professional Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule
3 relating to limited prescriptive authority for nurses in advanced practice.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARD TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Registered Professional Nurses.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on May 10, 2021, authorized under the
2 authority of §30-7-15a of this code, relating to the Board of Registered Professional Nurses
3 (Limited Prescriptive Authority for Nurses in Advanced Practice, [19 CSR 08](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Registered Professional Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Limited Prescriptive Authority for Nurses in Advanced Practice.
