1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to authorizing the Board of Registered Professional Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule
3 relating to telehealth practice.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Registered Professional Nurses.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 31, 2021, authorized under the
2 authority of §30-7-4 of this code, relating to the Board of Registered Professional Nurses
3 (Telehealth Practice, [19 CSR 16](#)), is authorized with the amendment set forth below:

4 On page 7, subsection 7.4, after the words, “standard of care” by inserting the words,
5 “with respect to an established patient”.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Registered Professional Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Telehealth Practice.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
