1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to authorizing the Secretary of State to promulgate a legislative rule relating to use of
3 digital signatures.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIESD AND BOARDS
TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Secretary of State.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2021, authorized under the
2 authority of §39A-3-3 of this code, modified by the Secretary of State to meet the objections of
3 the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on December
4 29, 2021, relating to the Secretary of State (Use of Digital Signatures, [153 CSR 30](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Secretary of State to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Use of Digital Signatures.
