A BILL supplementing and amending the appropriations of public moneys out of the State 1 2 Treasury from the balance of moneys remaining as an unappropriated balance in the State 3 Fund, General Revenue, to the Department of Commerce, Division of Natural Resources, 4 fund 0265, fiscal year 2022, organization 0310, by supplementing and amending the 5 appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022. 6 Whereas, The Governor submitted the Executive Budget Document to the Legislature on 7 January 12, 2022, containing a statement of the State Fund, General Revenue, setting forth 8 therein the cash balance as of July 1, 2021, and further included the revised estimate of revenue 9 for the fiscal year 2022, less net appropriation balances forwarded and regular and surplus appropriations for the fiscal year 2022; and 10 11 Whereas, It appears from the Governor's Statement of the State Fund, General Revenue, 12 there now remains an unappropriated balance in the State Treasury which is available for 13 appropriation during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022; therefore 14 Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia: 15 That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, to fund 0265, fiscal year 2022, organization 0310, be supplemented and amended by increasing existing items of 16 17 appropriation as follows: TITLE II – APPROPRIATIONS. 18 19 Section 1.
