Senate Bill 630

BY SENATORS BLAIR (MR. PRESIDENT) AND BALDWIN

(BY REQUEST OF THE EXECUTIVE)

[Introduced February 14, 2022; referred
to the Committee on Finance]

1 A BILL supplementing and amending the appropriations of public moneys out of the State
2 Treasury from the balance of moneys remaining as an unappropriated balance in the State
3 Fund, General Revenue, to the Higher Education Policy Commission, Higher Education
4 Policy Commission – Administration – Control Account, fund 0589, fiscal year 2022,
5 organization 0441, by supplementing and amending the appropriations for the fiscal year
6 ending June 30, 2022.

7 Whereas, The Governor submitted the Executive Budget Document to the Legislature on
8 January 12, 2022, containing a statement of the State Fund, General Revenue, setting forth
9 therein the cash balance as of July 1, 2021, and further included the revised estimate of revenue
10 for the fiscal year 2022, less net appropriation balances forwarded and regular and surplus
11 appropriations for the fiscal year 2022; and

12 Whereas, It appears from the Governor’s Statement of the State Fund, General Revenue,
13 there now remains an unappropriated balance in the State Treasury which is available for
14 appropriation during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022; therefore

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, to fund 0589, fiscal
17 year 2022, organization 0441, be supplemented and amended by increasing an existing item of
18 appropriation as follows:
