- A BILL to amend and reenact §64-3-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
- 2 authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule
- relating to emission standards for hazardous air pollutants.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 3. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-3-1. Department of Environmental Protection.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 21, 2022, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §22-5-4 of this code, relating to the Department of Environmental Protection (emission
- 3 standards for hazardous air pollutants, 45 CSR 34), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to emission standards for hazardous air pollutants.
