1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-8-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
 2 authorizing the Division of Motor Vehicles to promulgate a legislative rule relating to denial,  
 3 suspension, revocation, disqualification, restriction, nonrenewal, cancellation,  
 4 administrative appeals, and reinstatement of driving privileges.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 8. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO  
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64- 8 - 1. Division of Motor Vehicles.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2022, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §17A-2-9 of this code, modified by the Division of Motor Vehicles to meet the  
 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
 4 September 16, 2022, relating to the Division of Motor Vehicles (denial, suspension, revocation,  
 5 disqualification, restriction, nonrenewal, cancellation, administrative appeals, and reinstatement  
 6 of driving privileges, [91 CSR 05](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Division of Motor Vehicles to promulgate a legislative rule relating to denial, suspension, revocation, disqualification, restriction, non-renewal, cancellation, administrative appeals, and reinstatement of driving privileges.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
