A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to

authorizing the Board of Registered Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to

limited prescriptive authority for nurses in advanced practice.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Registered Nurses.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 26, 2022, authorized under the authority of §30-7-15a of this code, modified by the Board of Registered Nurses to meet the

objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on

4 November 10, 2022, relating to the Board of Registered Nurses (limited prescriptive authority for

5 nurses in advanced practice, 19 CSR 08), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Registered Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to limited prescriptive authority for nurses in advanced practice.
