1 A BILL to repeal §60A-10-16 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
2 eliminating the expiration date of the Multi-State Real-Time Tracking System.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 10. METHAMPHETAMINE LABORATORY ERADICATION ACT.**

**§1. Repeal of section setting an expiration date for the Multi-State Real-Time Tracking  
System.**

1 That §60A-10-16 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, is repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal the termination of the use of the Multi-State Real-Time Tracking System.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
