**Senate Bill 226**

1 A BILL expiring funds to the balance of the Department of Environmental Protection, Division of  
2 Environmental Protection – Reclamation of Abandoned and Dilapidated Property Program  
3 Fund, Fund 3305, Fiscal year 2023, organization 0313, in the amount of \$10 million, from  
4 the Executive, Governor's Office, Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund, Fund 8823,  
5 Fiscal year 2023, organization 0100, by supplementing and amending the appropriations  
6 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023.

7 Whereas, The Governor finds the account balance in the Executive, Governor's Office,  
8 Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund, fund 8823, organization 0100 exceeds that which is  
9 necessary for the purposes for which the account was established; therefore

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 That the balance of funds available for expenditure in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023,  
2 to Governor's Office, Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund, Fund 8823, Fiscal year 2023,  
3 organization 0100, be decreased by expiring the amount of \$10 million to the Department of  
4 Environmental Protection, Division of Environmental Protection – Reclamation of Abandoned and  
5 Dilapidated Property Program Fund, Fund 3305, Fiscal year 2023, organization 0313.

NOTE: The purpose of this supplemental appropriation bill is to expire and appropriate funds from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund to the Reclamation of Abandoned and Dilapidated Property Program Fund, Fund 3305, Fiscal year 2023.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
