A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
designated §18-2-25e, relating to allowing students to transfer schools and retain his or her
athletic eligibility at least one-time during a student's four years of secondary school.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
