- A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
- 2 authorizing the Department of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Grade
- 3 "A" pasteurized milk.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Department of Agriculture.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 21, 2022, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §19-11E-8(1) of this code, modified by the Department of Agriculture to meet the
- 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
- 4 September 22, 2022, relating to the Department of Agriculture (Grade "A" pasteurized milk, 61
- 5 CSR 15), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Grade "A" pasteurized milk.
