1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
 2 authorizing the Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to licensure,
 3 practice requirements, disciplinary and complaint procedures, continuing education, and
 4 physician assistants.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MISCELLANEOUS
 AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Medicine.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2022, authorized under the
 2 authority of §30-3E-3 of this code, relating to the Board of Medicine (licensure, practice
 3 requirements, disciplinary and complaint procedures, continuing education, physician assistants,
 4 [11 CSR 01B](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to licensure, practice requirements, disciplinary and complaint procedures, continuing education, physician assistants.
