1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
 2 authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Uniform  
 3 Controlled Substance Act.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MISCELLANEOUS  
 AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Board of Pharmacy.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 29, 2022, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §60A-3-301 of this code, modified by the Board of Pharmacy to meet the objections of  
 3 the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 17,  
 4 2022, relating to the Board of Pharmacy (Uniform Controlled Substance Act, [15 CSR 02](#)), is  
 5 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Uniform Controlled Substance Act.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
