1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
 2 authorizing the Board of Registered Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
 3 practitioner requirements for accessing the West Virginia Controlled Substance Monitoring
 4 Program database.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MISCELLANEOUS
 AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Registered Nurses.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 26, 2022, authorized under the
 2 authority of §60A-9-5a of this code, modified by the Board of Registered Nurses to meet the
 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
 4 November 10, 2022, relating to the Board of Registered Nurses (practitioner requirements for
 5 accessing the West Virginia Controlled Substance Monitoring Program database, [19 CSR 14](#)), is
 6 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Registered Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to practitioner requirements for accessing the West Virginia Controlled Substance Monitoring Program database.
