to abortion; and revising severability clauses.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2R. UNBORN CHILD PROTECTION ACT.

§16-2R-9. Severability.

Severability as provided in §2-2-10(b)(7) of this code is applicable to this article: *Provided*, That if this entire article is judicially determined to be unconstitutional, then the provisions of §16-Sec., §16-2I-1 *et seq.*, 16-2M-1 *et seq.*, §16-2O-1, §16-2P-1, §16-2Q-1, and §33-42-8 of this code shall become immediately effective: *Provided*, *however*, That if a provision or provisions of §16-2R-1 *et seq.* of this code are judicially determined to be unconstitutional, then the provisions of §16-2F-9, §16-2I-9, §16-2M-7, §16-2O-1(e), §16-2P-1(d), §16-2Q-1(m), and §33-42-8(d) of this code are not effective.
