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1	A Bill to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
2	designated §5D-1-5c, relating to the approval of decommissioning or deconstructing an
3	existing power plant; providing for rule-making authority; and exempting certain power
4	plants from approval requirement.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 1. PUBLIC ENERGY AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF WEST VIRGINIA.

§5D-1-5c. Approval of decommissioning or deconstructing an existing power plant.

- (a) No existing power plant shall undertake any decommissioning or deconstructing
 activities prior to obtaining approval from the authority.
 - (b) The authority may approve the decommissioning or deconstructing of an existing power plant upon the submission of a petition containing, at a minimum, the following information:
- (1) An analysis by an authority approved third party that evaluates the social.
 environmental, and economic impact at a local and statewide level of such decommissioning
 and deconstruction; and
 - (2) Potential alternatives to the decommissioning and deconstruction, including the reconstruction that make use of other technologies, including novel technologies and green technologies as alternative fuel sources.
 - (c) The authority shall propose rules for legislative approval and promulgate emergency rules in accordance with the provisions of §29A-3-1 et seq. of this code to implement this section, including exempting power plants that have been non-producing for at least five years prior to the effective date of this section.
