A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
designated §5D-1-5c, relating to the approval of decommissioning or deconstructing an
existing power plant.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 1. PUBLIC ENERGY AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF WEST VIRGINIA.

§5D-1-5c. Approval of decommissioning or deconstructing an existing power plant.

- 1 (a) No existing power plant shall undertake any decommissioning or deconstructing
- 2 activities prior to obtaining approval from the authority.
- 3 (b) The authority may approve the decommissioning or deconstructing of an existing
- 4 power plant upon the submission of a petition containing, at a minimum, the following information:
- 5 (1) An analysis by an authority approved third party that evaluates the social,
- 6 <u>environmental, and economic impact at a local and statewide level of such decommissioning and</u>
- 7 deconstruction; and
- 8 (2) Potential alternatives to the decommissioning and deconstruction, including the
- 9 reconstruction that make use of other technologies, including novel technologies and green
- 10 technologies as alternative fuel sources.
- 11 (c) The authority shall propose rules for legislative approval in accordance with the
- 12 provisions of §29A-3-1 et seq. of this code to implement this section.
